## **CIRCULAR**

- **Sub:** Scouts and Guides Training for Scout Masters & Guide Captains– Special training due to general transfer in Government schools-reg.
- Ref: 1. G.O (M S)14/2014/Gl.Edn date 15.01.2014
  2.Lr.No. STC/SMB/HSS/05/2016-17 dated 02/06/2016 of State Training Commissioner, Kerala State Bharath Scouts and Guides

As per reference cited, Government had accorded sanction to start Scouts and Guides units in Higher Secondary Schools. Accordingly 138 Scout Units& 145 Guide Units have been working in higher secondary schools. A few registered Scout masters & Guide captains were transferred to other schools during the last general transfer.

It is decided to conduct a Basic Training Programme for Scout masters and Guide captains from  $16^{th}$  to  $22^{nd}$  June 2016 for the teachers of the schools from where the Scout Masters/Guide captains transferred. When a registered Scout Master/Guide captain is transferred from a school, the unit will be permitted continue only if the another interested teacher completes the Basic Training for Scout Masters & Guide captains, successfully.

As per reference 2, the training for Scout Masters/ Guide captainsis scheduled to conduct from 16<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup>June 2016 at State Training centre, Palode.Schools willing to attend the Basic Training Programme have to register the name of schools at State Training Commissioner(S) Mobile No. 9446108176, State Training Commissioner(G) Mobile No. 9605159409 before **13<sup>th</sup> June 2016**. First 40 schools that register the name at State Training Commissioner(S)& (G) will be given opportunity to attend the basic Training Programme and give permission to continueScout Unit & Guide Units in their schools.

A teacher selected as Scout Master/ Guide captainof the selected schoolsshould attend the seven days residential programme. The selected teacher should not be in charge of Career Guidance unit, Souhrida Club, NCC, NSS and SPC.The teachers in-charge of Career Guidance/Souhrida Clubs should not be changed to Scouts/Guides without prior permission of the Director, Higher Secondary Education.

participants should be in correct and complete uniform as given below:

## Scout master

Shirt: A steel grey half sleeve shirt with two patch pockets and shoulder straps. **Pants:** Navy Blue Pants with loop at 2 inches.

**Head Dress:** Dark blue cap with official cap badge. Black Socks and Black Shoes with lace may be worn. Scarf and woggle will be given from the centre for the training purpose only. **Belt:** Grey Nylex, belt with official buckle of Bharat Scouts and Guides.

## Females:

**Saree and Blouse:** Steel grey Saree made of plain non transparent material, a steel grey blouse made of plain non transparent material with two patch pockets, half sleeves 8 cm about the elbow with turned up stitched down cuffs 4 cms, wide open sports collar with epaulettes on both shoulder. The blouse shall not be tight fitted. Cap and cap badge are not needed.

The participants should bring following items with them.

- 1. Light Bedding
- 2. Torch
- 3. Plate and Glass
- 4. Writing Materials
- 5. 3 meter cotton rope of 1 cm diameter for the use in the camp
- 6. Camp fee Rs. 350/-
- 7. Relieving order from Head of Institution

The participants should reach the venue at 8 am on 16<sup>th</sup> June 2016 at State Training Centre, Palode.

Scout& Guide Units in the school will exist only if the trained person will continue till the end of the academic year. Principals are advised to select the teacher for Scout Master & Guide Captain only if they continue in the same school till the end of the academic year. Principals are directed to relieve the teacher to attend the training programme in time.
