Sub: Career Guidance- **SITAR – Special Programme-Fashion Designing and Apparel Technology-Selection of students for the National Institute of Fashion Technology -reg.**

Ref: Government Order No. G.O. (Rt) 2912/2016/Gl. Edn dated 06/09/2016

Each year Career Guidance and Adolescent Counselling Cell of Department of Higher Secondary Education selects a particular area for providing specialized training to the students for bringing out multifaceted talents of the students. The specialized training will explore the opportunities of career options in selected area. As part of the programme, talented students will be provided opportunity to meet the maestros in the field and visit national level institutes of the selected area.

In the year 2012-13, Theatre was selected for specialized training and 50 students were given opportunity to visit National School of Drama, New Delhi. In the year 2013-14, Short Film was taken as specialized training area and 40 students got the opportunity to visit Film and Television Institute of India, Pune. During the year 2014-15, 40 talented students in the field of designing were given opportunity to visit National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad and in the year 2015-16, 40 students in the field of Media and Information were given opportunity to visit Indian Institute of Mass Communication and Journalism in New Delhi.

This year “Fashion Designing and Apparel Technology” is selected as subject for specialized training. Career Guidance and Adolescent Counselling Cell of DHSE has decided to plunge the interested students into this creative area through systematic training and interaction with the maestros. Students who are interested in the field of Fashion Technology will be given lessons on basic concepts and guide them to their dream career.

A state level workshop in association with National Institute of Fashion Technology, Kannur will be conducted NIFT Kannur for 40 selected students to make them aware in the basic concepts of fashion technology. The state level camp will be guided by the

professionals and experts. Later selected students will be given an opportunity to visit National Institute of Fashion Technology, Chennai and interact with the Experts.

The Career Guide/Souhrida Co-ordinator and the Principal of each school is directed to select **ONE First Year** student on the basis of an aptitude test to be conducted on **20th September 2016**. The questions will be issued to the principal via circular duly prepared by NIFT.

The selected student has to appear for the preliminary selection test at district centers scheduled on **24th September 2016 at 9.30am**. Top 40 scorers of the Preliminary Selection Test will be selected for the Programme. List of centers for the Preliminary Selection Test are given below:

District Level Selection Test:

Morning Session.

1. A class on courses and careers in Fashion Technology will be handled by the experts of National Institute of Fashion Technology Kannur, for the test appearing students and accompanying parents. The class will be for one and half hours (10.00 am to 11.30am).
2. Selection Test for one hour (11.45 am to 12.45 pm) the questions will assess the general knowledge and knowledge in Fashion design and apparel technology.

After Noon Session

Practical Exam on Fashion Design. Duration of the test will be 2 hrs (1.30 pm to 3.30 pm) the kit for the practical test will be provided.
